Sacramental Programs (2024-2025) First Reconciliation - First Holy Communion and Confirmation

At the entrances to the church are letters from the parish inviting families for the sacramental programs for next year (2025) beginning this coming fall: (First Reconciliation - First Holy Communion as well as Confirmation).

**Blessed Francis Mary of the Cross Jordan SDS
Venerable Founder of the Society of the Divine Saviour
(The Salvatorians)**

John Baptist Jordan was born on June 16, 1848 in Gurtweil, Germany, a small town in Baden (the southwestern part of the country), just a few kilometers from the district town of Waldshut, close to the Swiss border. When he was 13 years of age, while receiving his First Communion, he experienced a special grace which became leaven for his priestly vocation. The way to Fr. Jordan's ordination was long and hard primarily because of the extremely difficult material conditions of the family. Fr. Jordan's priestly ordination was received in 1878, in the church of the former Benedictine monastery at St. Peter's in Freiburg, Germany.

From the time of Fr. Jordan's theological studies, he had a growing conviction that he was being called by God to found a new way of apostolic mission in the Church, in which its members would defend the faith and contribute to enlivening it, by proclaiming to all people that Jesus Christ is the only Saviour. This conviction became even stronger during Fr. Jordan's trip to the Middle East in 1880. Within this vision, he wanted to start that which was not just another typical religious order, but, rather, a kind of 'association' which involved evangelization of not only the clergy but also the laity in different degrees connected with the society. No walk of life would be excluded in the apostolic mission. In this way, the apostolic work of the order and its purpose could be attained in all states of life.

Meanwhile, with the blessing of Pope Leo XIII, on December 8, 1881 at St. Brigid's Chapel in Rome, Father Jordan, together with two other companions began an Apostolic Teaching Society. Yet, Fr. Jordan returned to his vision and ideas for the future of an association which involved not only the clergy but also the laity.

The Church authority saw Fr. Jordan's vision and plans differently. They requested he provide a clear and (then) current principle of the founding of a new society which would be a religious order. Obedience which Fr. Jordan always showed to the Church authority led to the

transformation of his work in 1883 into the religious order under the name of The Society of the Divine Saviour (Salvatorians – from Latin "Salvator" means "Saviour"). And, John Baptist Jordan chose the new name of Francis Mary of the Cross.

In 1942, the cause for the Beatification of Father Francis Mary of the Cross Jordan was opened and in January 2011, the Holy Father, Pope Benedict XVI, signed the Decree of Venerability (Heroicity of Virtues). During the ordinary session of the Cardinals and Bishops of the Congregation of the Causes of Saints on June 19, 2020, the miracle attributed to the intercession of Father Francis Mary of the Cross Jordan was recognized, approved and promulgated by our Holy Father, Pope Francis. The date for the celebration of the beatification of Father Francis Mary of the Cross Jordan was set for May 15, 2021.

The charism of Fr. Francis Mary of the Cross Jordan was to help the Church to know, love and proclaim the one true God manifested in Jesus Christ, the Divine Saviour. Today, this is the true inspiration for many Salvatorian women and men religious, and lay, who work following the example of the apostles in more than 50 countries, scattered in the different continents: Europe, America, Asia, Australia and Africa -- working in the fields of education, evangelization, human and spiritual promotion, in missions and parish ministry.

Fr. Francis Mary of the Cross Jordan's beatification was held on May 15, 2021, in Lateran Basilica in Rome. His Feast Day is celebrated on July 21st, the anniversary of his ordination.

By their example, by means of the spoken and written word, and by all ways and means which love for Christ may inspire, the members should seek wisely and zealously in the Lord to make known to all and to glorify everywhere God the Father and His Son, Jesus Christ, and the Holy Spirit, in order to bring people to salvation.
