### Deaf and Mute

It didn't say in Mark's Gospel (7.31-37) what the man did with his life after he was cured of deafness and was then also able to speak.

Did he become a leader? What kind of a leader would he have been after once being deaf and mute and then having been given the gift of hearing and speech? Would he have worked remembering Jesus who cured him? Would he consider the Lord as his Master and lead as Jesus would have wanted him to – putting aside the popular consensus for the sake of virtue if popularity went against it?

For what reason is Jesus our Lord and Master? When he was with his chosen group of Apostles, they followed Him even when, as we heard in the readings of two weeks ago, his teachings were too hard for many others and those others could follow him no longer. For his chosen band, it wasn't the mutual admiration club. Jesus was their "teacher", not their instrument.

Moving towards the Lord is a continual lessening of deafness and gradual increase of learning virtue/truth to take the lead when it is necessary to speak up.

It doesn't matter whether it is an unaccepted Samaritan (from away) or a local (from here), when the ears of the deaf are unstopped and the tongue of the speechless sing for joy, and those words are given to them by instruction and then passed on to others, it is time to listen.

Is it possible that this is what the man did with his life after he was cured of deafness and was then also able to speak?
