

From now until the end of the month of November, if you would like to, so as to ease your burden, place their names in an envelope with a private offering for a Mass or a number of Masses to be said by our Pastor Fr. Robert, or one of his fellow Salvatorian Priests. These souls will be remembered as well at the Parish Memorial Mass by their names being placed in a special basket during its celebration.

On Saturday the 2nd of November the Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed (ALL SOUL'S DAY) there will be a Mass Celebrated at 9:00 am in the Morning (as well as at the Midnight Mass at 12:01 am – Following First Friday Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament)

Bringing Communion to the Sick & those Distributing Communion in the Church.

If you are bringing Communion to the sick (whether family members or others) and those who are distributing Communion in the church (Extraordinary Ministers), you will be commissioned once yearly at a special meeting for the parishioners who have been granted permission to act within these roles, by our Pastor, Fr. Robert, SDS.

And, those who are taking Holy Communion to the Sick are only to receive it from Fr. Robert, during the celebration of Holy Mass (not from the Deacon or Extraordinary Minister) because it is by the permission of the Pastor they are doing so. They are known and nominated by the Pastor. When the Pastor (Fr. Robert, SDS) is away, in that situation you can go to receive Communion from one of the Deacons because it is possible for them to verify if the person receiving is on the list that is in the Sacristy.

There are those parishioners who have already been prepared and were given a one-year commission to bring the Eucharist to the sick. They will continue to be commissioned yearly. (Please remember, in some circumstances civil clearance is necessary and needs to be completed.)

Parish Resources for those Bringing Holy Communion to the Sick:

- •The parish has prepared a booklet entitled "Guidelines for Communion Ministers to the Sick and Homebound". Some of the topics touched upon in the publication include: the recommended time to schedule this ministry; issues surrounding the timing of a visit to the person who is sick; working with more than one person who will be receiving Holy Communion; the length of a visit; how to carry Holy Communion to the sick; the requirements of who Communion Ministers are to be; the Pastoral Code of Conduct; preparing a respectful presentation during the visit; amongst other things.
- •A CCCB publication entitled "Communion of the Sick": within which is specified: *The Introductory Rites; The Liturgy of the Word; The Communion Rite; The Concluding Rites.*

In Closing: There is nothing simple or commonplace about bringing Holy Communion to the sick and/or distributing Holy Communion in the church. What has just been mentioned outlines the most rudimentary instructions as a starting point for those bringing Communion to the sick and those distributing Communion in the church. Fr. Robert, SDS

### A Simple Guideline as to how we are Receiving Holy Communion in the Church.

How to prepare – Gestures: When coming to the Priest, Deacon, or Extraordinary Minister, please make it clear whether you will be receiving the Host on the 'tongue' or on the 'hand'. If it is on the tongue, place your hands in a folded prayer position in front of your chest. If it is on the hand, hold your hands one folded over the other, palms facing upwards, 'higher' up in front of your chest, not below your waist. If you will be receiving a blessing, arms are bended at the elbow with the forearms crossed over your chest.

Receiving Holy Communion: When coming forward to Receive Holy Communion, prepare in silence or while singing. Consume the Host in front of the Priest, Deacon or Extraordinary Minister. After receiving Holy Communion, it is an important time of silence or to sing the hymns to give thanks.
