

Dear Friends in Christ,

Merry Christmas and Happy New Year!

My dear parishioners, we have been celebrating Christmas together for three years now. For me personally, these past three years have been very special - not easy, but definitely very special.

We have come a long way together and still have much to accomplish. I can see many changes in our parish. We are growing, albeit slowly, but we are definitely growing. Every day, we are getting better and better!

We have the potential to grow even further, both as a parish and as individuals. To overcome difficulties and problems. To share great faith and happiness. We can be united and grow together. This is my wish for you and for me. Two years ago, we struggled to find musicians for Christmas - this year, we had a Christmas concert! This concert showed us just how much potential we have.

During the Christmas celebration, we are reminded that Jesus is the Prince of Peace. "For to us a child is born, to us a son is given, upon his shoulders dominion rests. And he will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace" (Is. 9:6).

And from the Gospel of Luke, "A multitude of the heavenly host appeared with the angel, praising God and saying: "Glory to God in the highest heaven, and on earth peace to those on whom his favor rests." (Lk 2:13-14)
