Fill the Jars with Water: Who knows of the workings of those in charge? When the water was turned into wine the steward in charge took the bridegroom to task saying, "Everyone serves the good wine first, and then the inferior wine after the guests have become drunk. But you have kept the good wine until now." So, the steward implied that the good wine had been wasted, would be unappreciated, and had no value. But the servants knew what was going on, because they had filled the jars with water. Something so right, and other than His Mother and disciples, the servants were the only ones who knew what was going on. It gives us a lot of hope when our good acts go unrecognized because that is how it was at the time of the very first of Jesus' miracles in his ministry at the wedding in Cana. ... And you who do good acts, remember your servants who see your goodness – do you recognize them? St. John did, because the servants were mentioned in this Sunday's Gospel.
