

Can you think of a time when you were young, you might have wanted to offer your whole heart and soul to God and were so happy because it seemed a door to do so had opened? But then, unexpectedly, someone standing beside you more desirable and worthy was chosen and you were put aside. Maybe you were scandalized and considered forever walking away from the call. Or maybe after years of not abandoning your offer to God, on so unexpected a road you realized you were on the path after all. It just didn't end up taking the direction you thought it would. This is so often how mission is. It is only God who reveals it to us.

"Woe is me! I am lost, for I am a man of unclean lips, and I live among a people of unclean lips; yet my eyes have seen the King, the Lord of hosts!" ... Then I heard the voice of the Lord saying, "Whom shall I send, and who will go for us?" And I said, "Here am I; send me!" (Isaiah 6:5,8)
