

Penitential Discipline

All the faithful in their own way are bound by divine law to do penance; however, in order for the entire community to be joined in a common observance of penance, penitential days have been prescribed during which the faithful are asked to engage in a special way in prayer, works of piety, and charity, deny themselves by fulfilling more faithfully their responsibilities, and observe fast and abstinence according to canonical norms.

Specific Days

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast and abstinence from meat or similar food.

(Cannon Law)

In the Catholic tradition, fasting means to consume only one full meal a day. Two smaller meals equal to or less than one full meal are allowed as an alternative. Abstinence within fasting means not to eat meat.

It is also expected that meat is to be given up on Fridays during Lent.

TOTAL CONSECRATION TO MARY COURSE

As Roman Catholics we are all aware of the importance of our Blessed Mother Mary. Did you know that when we consecrate ourselves to her our understanding and blessings simply explode? At Resurrection of Our Lord Parish we are pleased to host the talks that form part of a course, that began on February 8th with a talk by Fr. Pierre Champoux

On March 8th at 6pm in the church hall there will be an informal supper, bring your own meals to share for those in the consecration class. Please join us. Class participants are sent videos on the consecration and reflections on the theology and importance of such a tremendous event. Many will say 'why do I need it?'. It is the FASTEST track to sainthood. I don't know about you, but I always prefer fast tracks!

Our next gathering will take place on March 8th 2025 at 6pm in the church hall for dinner and discussion. At 7pm in the sanctuary we are honoured to have Fr. Hezuk Shroff as our guest speaker.

Fr. Hezuk is a diocesan priest who had a remarkable conversion story from Zorastrianism to Roman Catholicism. He was in formation to become a Benedictine Monk and later joined a missionary order called the Brothers of St. John. He is fluent in French and Latin and English.

He is an outstanding liturgist and has a very profound knowledge of both the liturgy and the Divine Office. He is an excellent speaker and will grace us with a lecture on the theology behind our consecration to Mary,

Fr. Hezuk has been a priest for 15 years. He is the spiritual director for the Legion of Mary and has a deep devotion to our Blessed Lady who was instrumental in his call to the priesthood.

Do not miss this opportunity.

On April 12th, 2025 at Resurrection Parish we will have a special mass for consecration. This will be officiated by the Heralds of the Gospel. There will be a semi professional choir in attendance singing and participants will experience the power and the blessings of this solemn consecration.
