

LENT - 40 Days in the Desert **PENANCE** - Fasting / Prayer / Almsgiving

(Catechism of the Catholic Church)

As an expression of penance, Scripture and the Fathers insist above all on three forms of penance: fasting, prayer and almsgiving. These are ways to attain conversion in relation to ourselves, to God and to others. JOY (Jesus, Others, You). Fasting, prayer and almsgiving are means of obtaining forgiveness of sins: efforts at reconciliation with one's neighbour, tears of repentance, concern for the salvation of one's neighbour, the intercession of the saints and practice of charity "which covers a multitude of sins". (1434, 1438) (Lent is an intense time of the Church's penitential practice.) When we are part of the Church it means we have a moral life and it's sustained when we take part in liturgical life. There are things we have to do as a minimum to grow in the spirit of prayer and to be moral so we can grow in love of God and our neighbour. The fifth Precept of the Church says that we shall observe the prescribed days of fasting and abstinence. This makes sure that there is penance to prepare us for liturgical feasts. (It helps us to acquire mastery over our instincts and freedom of heart.) 2041 & 2043. It's hard to give things up, but Jesus was in the desert for 40 days. We don't have a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but one who in every respect has been tested as we are, yet [He] without sinning. By the solemn forty days of Lent the Church unites herself each year to the mystery of Jesus in the desert. (540)

Be with me Lord when I am in Trouble

The threat of deterioration so often seems to be the reality that motivates fear and can lead to sin. Some people live with insecurity for differing reasons, their entire lifetime. To not be shaken or tempted in such places of wilderness, everyone needs something given by God. And Jesus is the way. He said, "Whoever believes in me", as scripture says, "Rivers of living water will flow from within him." (John 7:38). It wasn't a temple of stone that Jesus rebuilt in three days. It was the temple of his body. He wants to rebuild us, demolish the places of fear. They are places where no one else except He knows the way to enter and heal. Whether you are being treated harshly and inflicted, whether you are in trouble, whether you need help at a time of trouble, or whether you are being tested, it is the offers of the tempter to make things better through sin that needs be overcome. We've been given the assurance that grace will abound all the more over sin. It will always be so. Pray for the virtue of patience during times of deterioration and rail against fear - not succumbing to sin. Cry out to the Lord and remember, He was tempted by the devil in the desert in the same way you are also being tested.

When the Egyptians treated us harshly and afflicted us, by imposing hard labour on us, we cried to the Lord, the God of our fathers; the Lord heard our voice and saw our affliction, our toil, and our oppression.

(Deuteronomy 26:6-7)
